If You Land on one of these spaces:

Free Read: Read any book of your choice

Electric Company: Read a thriller or mystery

Water Works: Read a sad book

Go to Jail: Move your piece to jail and read a banned book

Train of Thought: Read a book inspired by that certain location

Chance: Read a Random Book of your To Be Read (TBR) shelf
